This day we will visit the Nike Missile Site SF-88L, the only restored Nike site in the country, the Marine Mammal Center, and the historic but still active lighthouse. Logistics: Carpooling is highly recommended due to scarce parking. Bring your own water to Pt. Bonita. Walk to Pt Bonita is moderately steep ½ mile. Allow 1 hour travel time from Martinez, Santa Rosa or Walnut Creek. Maps of the Marin Headlands Unit will be mailed to attendees (at the park entrance, turn right to the Tunnel Road).
