At the end of the off-ramp, turn LEFT and enter the tree-lined drive to the Home on the hill. The meeting room will be in the large white building at the end. Parking is to the left across from the Member Services Building, #60. We will be in the large bright Cafeteria which has not yet reopened after very extensive renovation, on the second floor. Elevator available.

If you are interested in spending Friday evening or staying over Saturday evening, there are a number of motels along I-80 in Fairfield area.....about a 45 minute drive to Yountville. Also two or three along Highway 29 between Vallejo and Napa.....Holiday Inn Express and Fairfield Inn & Suites, about 30 minutes from Yountville, and John Muir Inn about 15 minutes from Yountville. Google should be a valuable tool!?!

For those coming from Nevada, Sacramento, Stockton, etc. you can take Highway 12 from I-80 westbound across to Highway 29. Nice scenic drive and cuts off many miles. At Highway 29, turn north (right) toward Napa.
